- La Salle Amman is a member of the **Lasallian** family all around the world.
- Our founder John Baptist de La Salle was born in 1651 in France.
- He was the first son of wealthy parents living in France over 350 years ago.
- At that time a few people lived in luxury, but most of the people were extremely poor.
- He determined to put his own talents and advanced education at the service of the children.
- so he formed the community that became known as the **Brothers of the Christian Schools**



De La Salle College - Amman

- The foundation of the school in Amman was initiated by the Alumni of De la Salle schools in Jerusalem, Jaffa and Haifa in 1948
- The Brothers studied the situation and did the necessary advance with the government and King Abdallah 1st encouraged them.
- The Brothers rented a house in 1950 on Jabal Amman to start with.
- This was the beginning of this new campus on Jabal Al-Hussein in 1950.
- In 2009, Mr. Gabi Ghazzawi was appointed as first lay director of the school.
- Mr. Ghazzawi his mission is to introduce several education programs into the school; such as CP, IG, MYP, PYP, DP, IB, SAT.

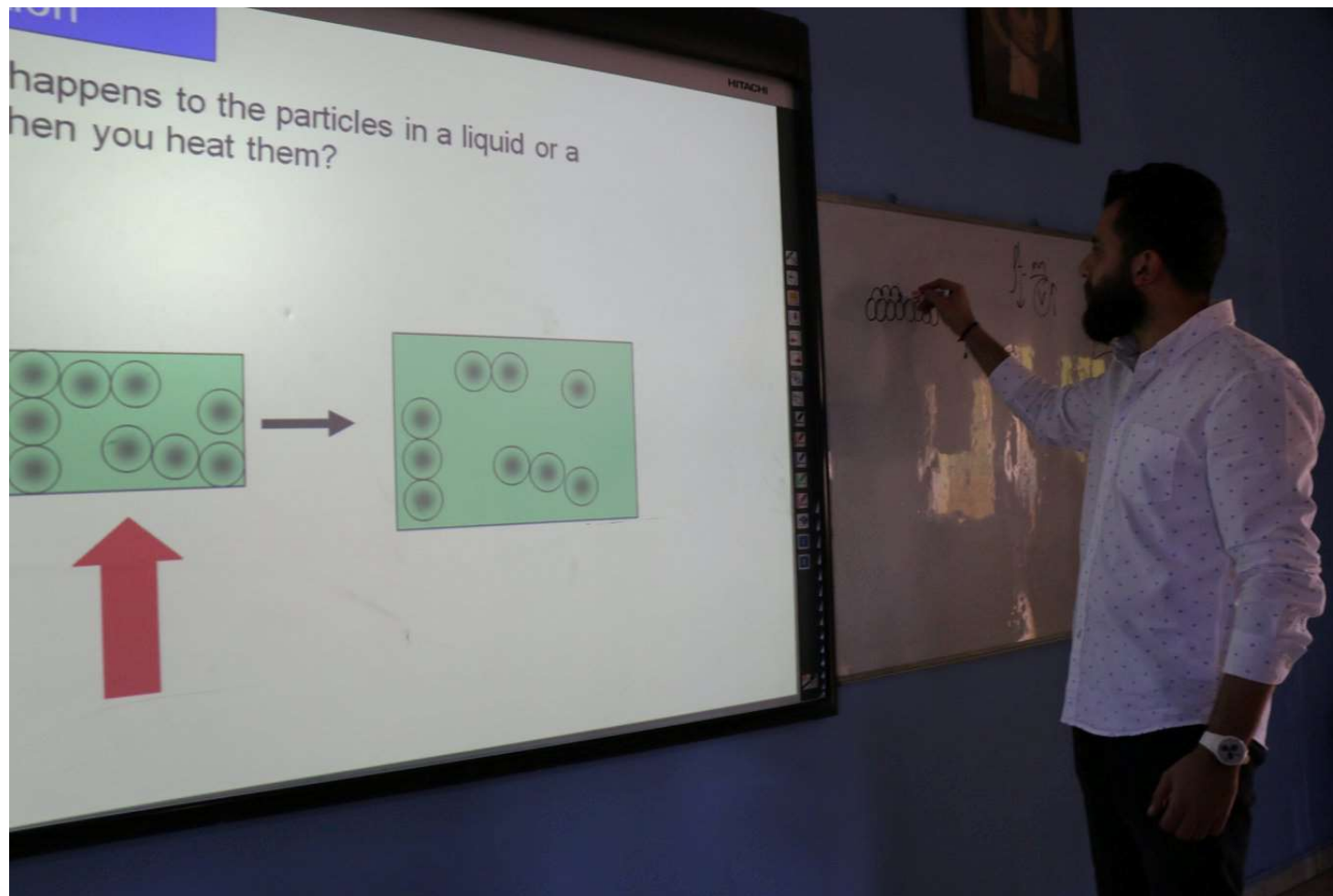
